Program Description: The Warrell Unit is the largest Urogynaecology Center in England. There are five subspecialists Consultant Urogynaecologist and one clinical scientist. We provide formal GMC recognized fellowships, these include the RCOG Urogynaecology subspecialty training program (Dr Karen Ward is the Program Director) and the ATSM in Laparoscopic Urogynaecology (preceptor Dr Rohna Kearney) and also an ATSM general urogynaecology (preceptor Dr Maya Basu). There are opportunities for research fellowships with Manchester University , candidates can register for MRes , MPhil , MD or PhD. We also have some opportunities for clinical fellowships for 1 or 2 years and some short-term clinical observerships.
