ABOUT HYDERABAD



Hyderabad, in the newly formed Telangana State, is known by the sobriquet city of Pearls. The city is one of the largest metros in India with an area of 650 square kilometres (250 sq mi), having a population of 6.8 million in the city and 7.7 million in the metropolitan area, making it the fourth most populous city and the sixth-most populous urban agglomeration in the country.

Hyderabad was established in 1591 AD on the banks of the Musi river on the tip of the Deccan Plateau by Sultan Muhammad Quli Qutb Shah. Now known as the historic old city, home to the Charminar, Falaknuma Palace, Chowmahalla Palace and Makkah Masjid, it lies on the southern bank of the river.

The twin cities of Hyderabad and Secunderabad, separated by the Hussain Sagar (bound by the 'Tank Bund'), a man-made lake made during the time of Ibrahim Qutb Shah in 1562, come under the ambit of a single municipal unit the Greater Hyderabad Municipal Corporation.

Hyderabad was once a global center of the diamond and pearls trade. The city has emerged as a major global center for the information technology (IT) industry and biopharmaceutical industry. The Telugu film industry, known as Tollywood is also located in the city. As of March 2012, Hyderabad is the "Best Heritage City" of India and home to many historical sites, including the UNESCO Asia Pacific Heritage site of Chowmahalla Place. The city is a regular tourist hotspot and carries many places of interest.

Situated on the crossroads of North and South India, Hyderabad has been noted for its unique culture, art and architecture.
